

Vinland Uniform Dress Code

Uniforms are required of all Vinland students. We believe our uniform policy directly relates to our students' potential to achieve higher academic goals.

Vinland Colors

All articles of clothing must be solid colors of navy blue, forest green, khaki, or white. Any visible layers must also be in Vinland solid colors. The only acceptable logo on clothing is the Vinland dolphin logo.

Outer Layers

Sweatshirts, sweaters, and vests in solid Vinland colors, as well as Vinland logo sweatshirts, may be worn indoors.

Styles and Fabrics

- Skirts, dresses, and shorts must meet the "finger tip" rule: fabric must extend below fingertips when arms are held at side.
- T-shirts in solid Vinland colors are acceptable. Tank tops may be worn provided the straps measure at least two fingers wide.
- Blue denim jeans, undershirts, and camisoles are not permitted.
- Knee socks, tights, and leggings must be solid uniform colors. Ankle socks do not need to be uniform colors.

Headwear

Hats, bandanas, bandana material or scarves may not be worn indoors. Headbands will be less than 2" wide.

Jackets and Coats

Outerwear does not need to be in uniform colors.

Shoes

Students should wear activity appropriate footwear. Shoes open at the toes or heels are not permitted.

General guidelines regarding uniforms:

- Clothing must be neat and clean with no holes or tears.
- Baggy clothing, larger than one size or more above the student's regular size, is not permitted.
- Students may wear uniforms of nationally recognized youth organizations such as Cub Scouts or Girl Scouts on their scout meeting days.
- Cosmetics and fragrances are not permitted.

If students come to school dressed inappropriately, staff will help them find appropriate clothing from our uniform closet or notify family.

On Free Dress Days, students shall dress appropriately for school and still follow the general guidelines listed above.
